Landowners not liable for snowmobile accidents!

A panel of New Hampshire legislators has good news for landowners who allow snowmobiles to use their property.

The committee has concluded those landowners are protected against lawsuits prompted by snowmobiles injured in accidents on their property, as long as the owners don't do anything intentionally to cause the accident.

The lawmakers say the property owners are covered for up to \$2 million in liability insurance paid for by off-road registration fees as well as private homeowner policies.
