HERE COMES THE GROOMER!

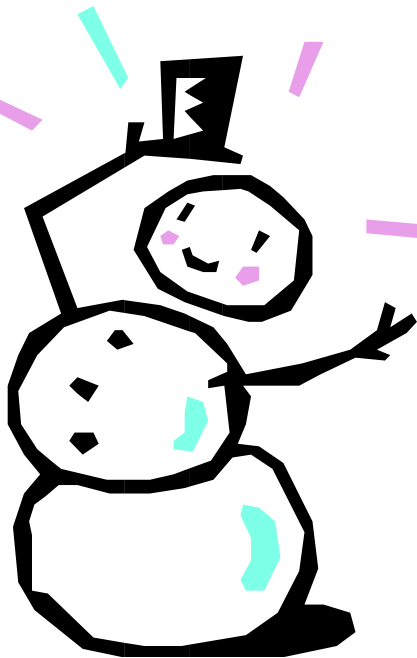

the groomer. When you approach the groomer stay as far as possible to the right of the trail, if not off the trail completely. This will not only protect the driver of the groomer but also YOU!



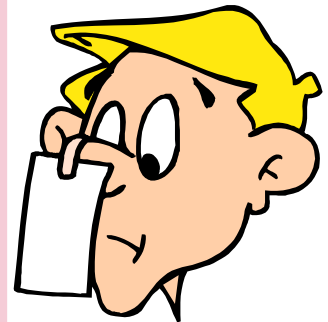
