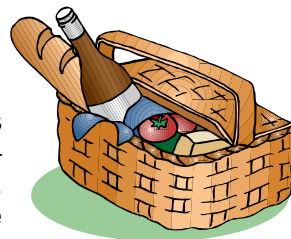

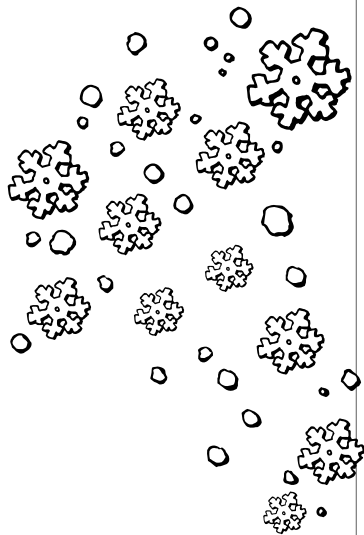
burgers and sausage, coffee and hot chocolate. This is free for all members, it is \$3.00 for non-members. We

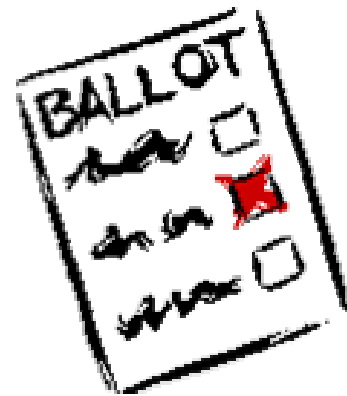
## Election of Officers
